Program Overview

The Summer Opportunity Program is designed to help students repair or recover credits needed to graduate high school. It is also designed to allow students to take selected initial credit courses. We prepare students to be college or career ready and to excel beyond graduation.

Program Goals

- To assist students with their transition from high school to an academically challenging post-secondary or career option through a virtual experience that is designed to give students a better chance to graduate high school.
- To further develop students' growth mindset so they will be mentally prepared for the challenges of high school and post-secondary options.
- To help students discover how they learn best by exposing them to research-based instruction.
- To celebrate students' growth through the use of PBIS.

Programs Offered in SOP:

- Credit Repair (final grade between 64% - 69%)
- Credit Recovery (final grade between 0 – 63%)
- Initial Credit (British Literature, Environmental Science, Spanish I & World History)

Cost:

Technology Requirements: Computer Access to Edgenuity with Camera & Internet

Course Outline:

All online courses will follow the same outline: Introduction, Vocabulary Review, Lecture/Video, Instructional Links (must click and take notes), Quiz, Topic Review, & Cumulative Exam. Some Science courses will require a lab and some ELA courses will require some essays.

Student Requirements:

1. Maintain e-notes or written notes (using a spiral or composition book).
2. All notes must be dated. Teachers will review student's notes prior to giving an additional assessment or quiz. Teacher will remediate students on all failed assessments prior to allowing them an additional attempt.
3. Notes can be used during your assessments.
4. Students will not be given checks to verify answers, so they must take thorough notes.
