Schools may have more than one TC Coordinator, each person should complete a survey.
- Review the Technology Competition guidelines regarding school level deadlines, project category information, judging rubrics, etc. All guidelines are located on the Technology Competition website.
- Begin communication with students, staff, and parents promoting the Technology Competition.

Schools may register up to **two (2) projects** in each grade level category to compete at the Regional level.
