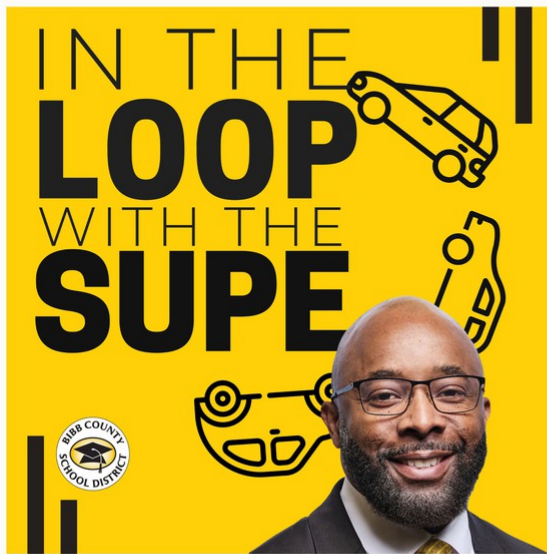
"Not only are you helping other people, but you're helping yourself to be a better person," said Ballard-Hudson seventh-grader Magely Abara.
